Title of winning work: *"Y-W-B: THIS IS THE RIGHT BIN!"*

Brief description of the activity (3-5 lines): The students attended to a workshop that consisted on learning about the characteristics of clay and ceramics and how they are worked; they modelled one piece with their own hands, and they painted it with a decoration of their choice. Thanks to it they developed both their artistic knowledge and skills while working in group. Even if each one created their own piece, they shared what they were doing with the rest of the group to get inspiration or suggestions, therefore sharing ideas.

The students enjoyed everything related to this workshop: the explanation regarding how clay works, and how it is worked throughout the different phases of the process of creating a piece (modelling, pasting parts, painting, 'baking'); the possibility of developing their creativity when choosing and designing the shape and decoration of their piece; and the chance to work together as a group in a calm and relaxing space.

- What new skills or knowledge did the participant(s) gain?

Students enhanced their knowledge on clay and ceramics, and learnt how to work their hands, together with different tools and materials, to achieve the design they imagined.

- How will this experience help the participant(s) in developing their talent further?

This experience has stimulated the students curiosity on different artistic technics, in this case, a traditional one such as pottery, directly linked with the Mediterranean culture in general, and Spanish in particular, to the point that they are already thinking on doing another workshop related to it.
