1. Winner(s) and Activity

Name(s) of winner(s): “Don Locanetto” primary school, Rivoli, Italy

Title of winning work: “Once upon a...change”

Brief description of the activity (3-5 lines): The project **“A Fairytale School”** was created with the goal of enhancing each student’s creativity and expressive abilities through art workshops and active citizenship activities. Starting from observing the plants around the school and in collaboration with the Museum of Contemporary Art, the students designed and created murals on the exterior walls, transforming common spaces into colorful and meaningful places. The school thus became an enchanted forest, where dreams of peace and equality can flourish.

2. Experience & Learning

- What did the participant(s) enjoy most about this activity?

The children really enjoyed transforming the school into an “enchanted forest” by creating murals on the exterior walls. They enjoyed working in small groups, experimenting with different painting techniques, and collaborating with each other. They found it exciting to express their creativity and reflect on the values of peace, equality, and respect, making the shared spaces more welcoming and meaningful.

- What new skills or knowledge did the participant(s) gain?

The children learned to use different artistic techniques, plan and create a collective work, and communicate through art. They developed collaboration skills, a sense of belonging to the school community, organizational abilities, and teamwork skills. They also deepened their understanding of contemporary art as an expressive and inclusive language, learning to value their own ideas while respecting those of others.

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- How will this experience help the participant(s) in developing their talent further?

The experience stimulated their creativity, autonomy, and ability to work with others. It helped the children recognize and develop their artistic talents, feel confident in sharing ideas, and understand the importance of working for the common good. Thanks to this project, they will be able to continue cultivating their creative and social skills in a climate of inclusivity, collaboration, and mutual respect.
